Startup Train will begin its inaugural railway journey on the Amtrak Acela in Providence, RI and end in Washington, D.C. with stops in New York, Philadelphia and Baltimore. For the cities who fall on Wednesday, Lightship plans to host its founder meetup, Workflow Wednesday. This is designed to be a learning playground for founders to have opportunities to participate in showcases and to connect with other local businesses.

"At Lightship we value the history and purpose of the US railways, so we've decided to dedicate one week every year to riding the rails between ecosystems where our resources and network will offer the most meaningful support," said Candice Mathews Brackeen, Lightship Foundation Founder and CEO.

Lightship hopes the Startup Train will encourage connectivity and collaboration within ecosystems, while bolstering investor deal flow and achieving greater revenue and funding outcomes for funders in those cities.
